Head of School's Report

The 2016 School year was a year characterised by student enthusiasm, curriculum development and internal and external success. Changes in the education sector are leading to new imperatives for schools across the country. Government priorities include improving science and mathematics standards and new requirements for University entry. As a School, we looked at our own priorities. Our desire to more clearly express our School's values led to the development of RISE - Respect, Integrity, Service and Excellence – a clear path for our future.

This year we have also put emphasis on ensuring all students have access to challenging curriculum that meet their future needs. Our desire to provide best practice in educational delivery began with staff revising teaching programmes and examining pedagogy. The History and Science Units based on Inquiry Learning for primary and problem and inquiry based learning activities in secondary faculties were starting points. Our first accelerated Mathematics class began in Year 9 and students at Park Campus enjoyed the Kids

Coding programme as well as Mandarin as part of their educational programme. Planning for a Year 9 iStem elective began.

Our decision to begin a significant project in Vietnam and offer students opportunities to contribute to a school and orphanage in Vung Tau has already had an impact. Fundraising across the year including the recent highly successful soccer day, have delivered visible results. In 2016 we set up a hairdressing training centre and library for the school. Our first student trip to Vietnam in December was highly successful.

Developing these strengths of character, our co-curricular programme expanded to its greatest extent in 2016. Ensuring a wider selection of options including Dance, Tai Kwon Do, Coding, Musical Theatre, Rugby development and Athletics. The numbers of students involved in all areas of the Music programme increased and for many of our students, success in some of our largest and more traditional sports such as touch football, rowing and netball capped off a terrific year.



In 2016 we launched our new Learning Management System, SchoolBox and we hope this will both improve communication with home through the parent portal as well as make home-school links for students a positive experience.

Please enjoy the Mitre and the images that highlight our busy, dynamic and engaging School in 2016.

HSC 2016 Report

Our Year 12 students again excelled in the Higher School Certificate, achieving outstanding results both individually and as a School. In 2016, Newcastle Grammar School maintained its position as the leading Independent School in the Hunter Region ranking 64th out of more than 650 schools in NSW.

This year, the Dux of the School was Azleen Akhand who received an ATAR of 99.8 with 33% of students received an ATAR over 90 and 47% of students received an ATAR over 85.

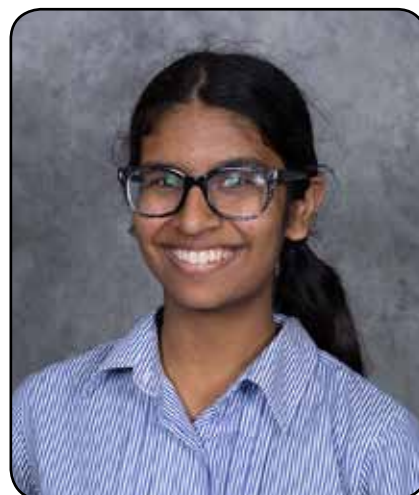
Five students were included on the All Round Achievers list - Azleena Akhand, Isabella Cesta, Olivia Dickinson, Elizabeth Sebastian and Rebekah Stuart (achieving 90 or more in 10 course units).

36 students were named on the Distinguished Achievers list with 120 results over 90% (achieving 90 or more in a course). Newcastle Grammar School students performed well above the state average in most courses. This reflects our long-standing exemplary academic record.

Alexander Young was first in the State for Music 1 with his HSC Music performance selected for the 2016 ENCORE Music performance. Cassidy Lobb, Emily Spurway and Oliver Watt were nominated for selection for ENCORE.

Jessica Finlay-Jones was ninth in the State for Drama and was nominated for both individual performance and for her group performance for OnStage. The other students nominated in the group performance were Grace Byth, Olivia Dickinson and Cassidy Lobb.

Asha Ryan and Matthew Wiseman's HSC Technology projects were nominated for the 2016 Shape (Design & Technology) Exhibition.

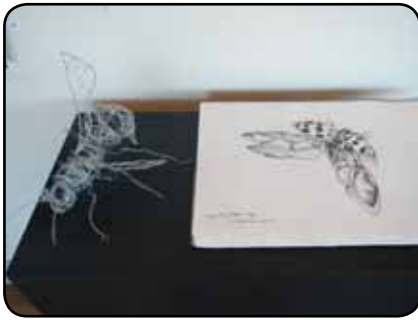

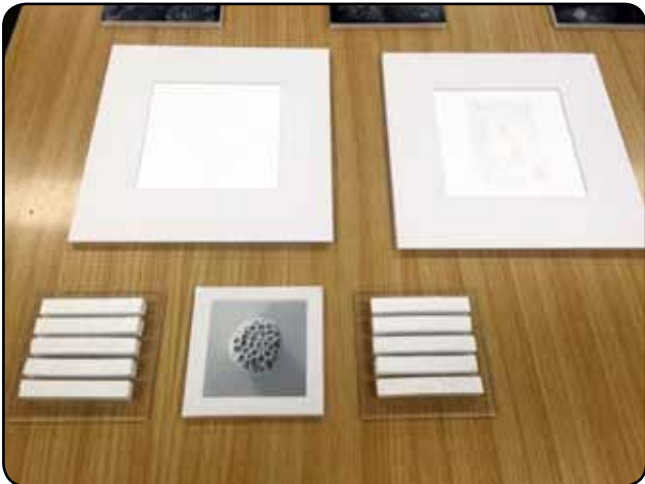

Our broad Co-curricular programme offers students 20 sports in which they can participate under the guidance of experienced and dedicated coaching and management staff.

- Over 75 teams, on top of the large number of teams/individuals involved in Rowing (114 students), Aerobics (13 students), Athletics (52 students), Sailing (17 students), Skateboarding 17 students), Surfing (18 students), Surf Lifesaving (10 students), Taekwondo (36 students), Rugby (17 students) and Milo Cricket (40 students in skills sessions), have represented/are currently representing, NGS (K-12) in various Newcastle Junior sporting competitions in the 2016 or 2015/16 seasons. These sports include Basketball (37 students/3 teams), Futsal (115 students/15 teams), Hockey (16 students/1 team), Netball (88 students/9 teams), Soccer (57 students/6 teams), Tennis (36 students/17 teams) and Touch (130 students/15 teams).

31 members of the NGS teaching staff and over 65 coaches drawn from the Newcastle community assist in the coaching/managing and supervision of our teams in the Co-curricular sporting programme.

- This year, NGS once again entered the NSW Interschools' Snowsports programme with our team of three Snowboarders, Taj Curren Otto Dries and Lachlan Dunning working their way through Regional and NSW competitions to represent the School in the National Championships.



- The NGS Rowing team currently comprises 114 rowers for the beginning of the 2016/17 season and also had another outstanding season in 2015/16 with the following great results:

- The Surf Lifesaving programme has also achieved great success and recognition within the community with four students having completed their Surf Lifesavers Award which included the Bronze Medallion, spinal, first aid, advanced resuscitation and radio. Six more students continued training for IRB crew and maintained active patrols at



Cooks Hill Surf Lifesaving Club. Patrol #14 members, Matthew McNeil, James Sara, Steven Howell, Mikey Cominos and Patrol Captain Paul Lumley were awarded Heroes of the Surf recognition at the Branch Annual Awards Presentations, for the critical incident management of a young lady with a suspected spinal injury which occurred whilst they were on patrol earlier this season.



NGS Staff have also been very active in our sporting programme: Mr Hopson coached the HRIS Open representative boys Basketball team to their third Championship win in four years at the AICES Championships, Mr Lumley is now in his 3rd year as Patrol Captain with the Cooks Hill SLSC and routinely leads our Patrol whilst they look after the safety of beach-goers, Ms Byrnes was once again selected in the NSW Over 35's Women's Touch side and always brings the latest game techniques and ideas to the NGS Touch programme, and Mrs Ellis was one of only two women from NSW to receive a full scholarship to attend the 2016 Rowing Australia 'Women Leaders in Rowing' course held at the AIS in November - a huge achievement.

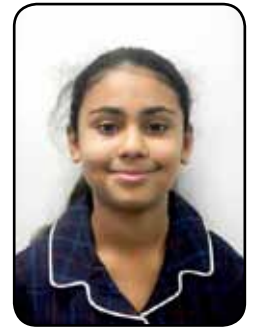

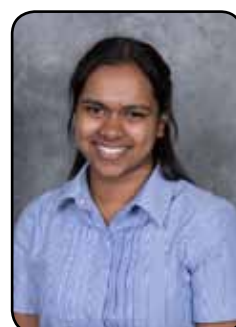

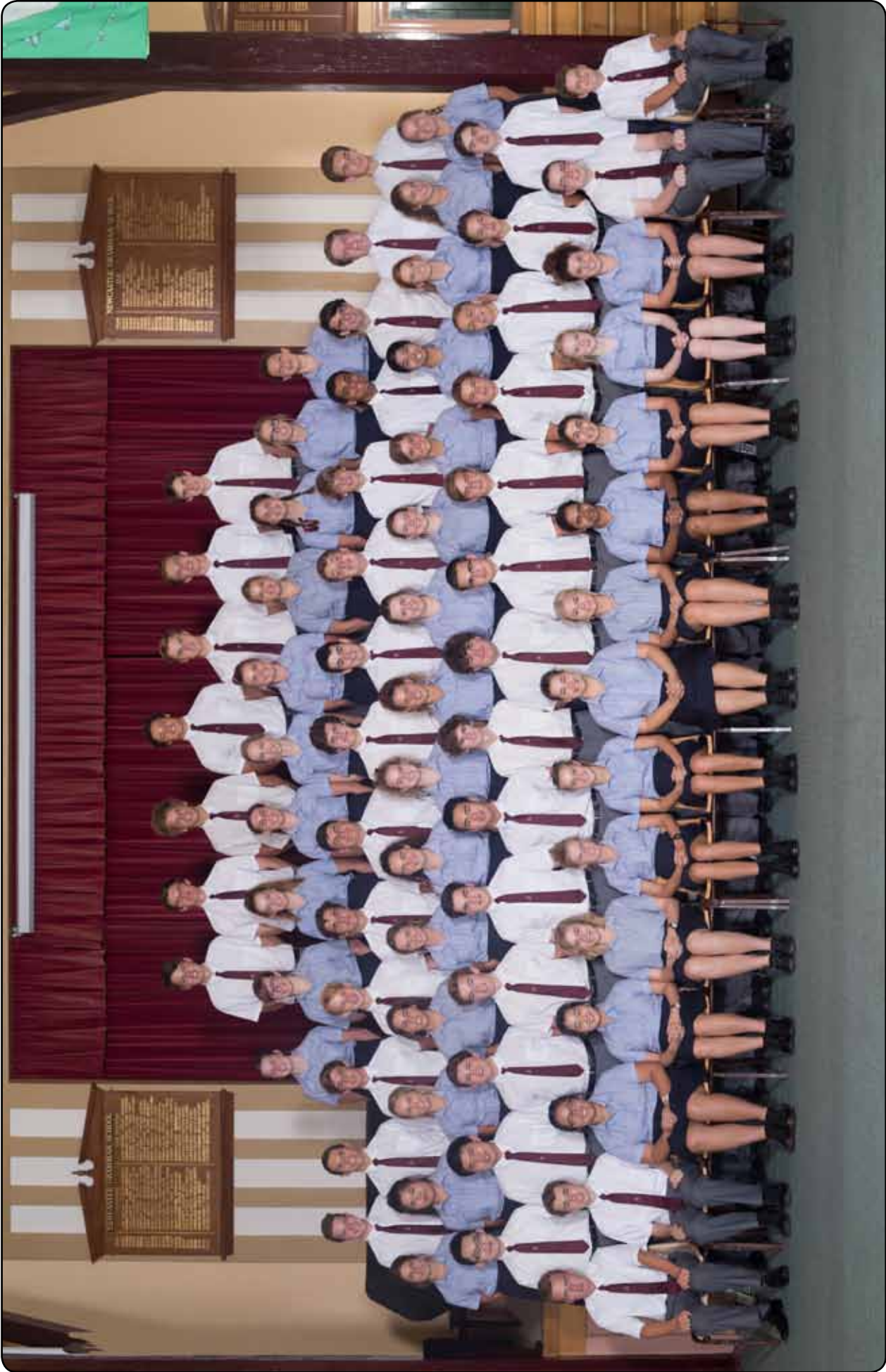
